## **From the ECA Coordinator's Desk**

*Extra Curricular Activities are an integral part of the CIS curriculum ensuring all round holistic development of our students.*

*At CIS we offer ECA's as optional activities to Grades 1 and 2 as they are just stepping into the arena of self reliance and sportsmanship. They are introduced to only 4 ECA activities that stress more on the development of Fine Motor skills and Bodily Kinaesthetic skills. These include Table Tennis, Taekwondo, Western dance and Football.*

*Considering grades 3 - 8 to be the most crucial age in a child's life in terms of physical, emotional and mental development we make it compulsory for the students of these grades to take up at least one ECA activity in a session.*

### **ECA ORIENTATION**

*The ECA orientation for the new academic year was held at C.I.S on the 24th of June, 2017. Parents were given the chance to interact with the ECA coaches personally which helped them to identify the strengths of their children and choose the ECAs accordingly.*
