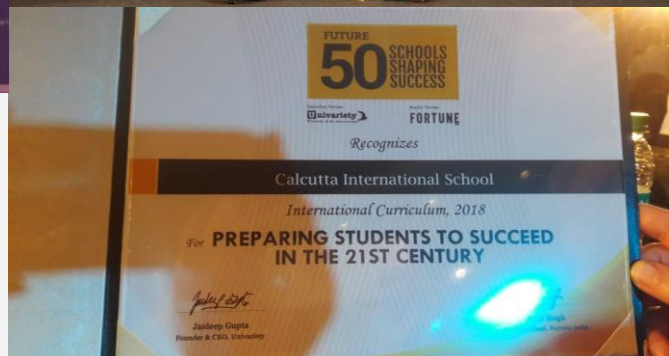

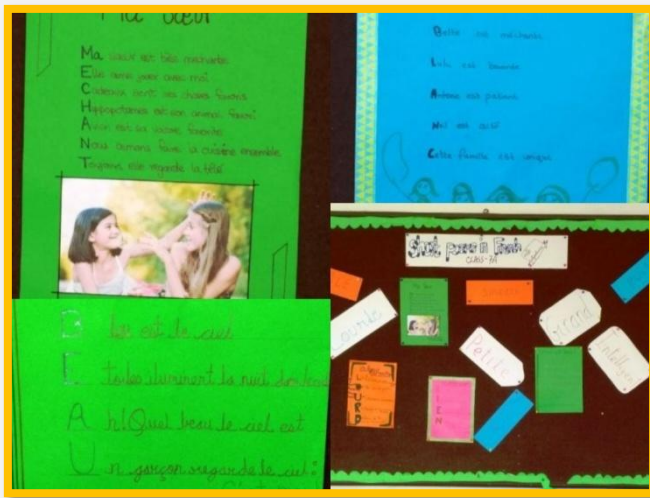
**CIS receives a Certificate of Achievement for participating in "Daan Utsav 2018" from Hope Kolkata Foundation.**
